PROSPECTUS

Little Flower Vidyanikethan & Junior College, Mundathanam, is established by the Congregation of the Missionaries of Little Flower in the Archdiocese of Changanacherry, in the year 1992.

Objectives

Our school intends to shape every student to a wholesome personality ensuring good character, genuine love for humanity and service to fellowmen as well as developing qualities of leadership, independent thinking and courageous adherence to principles. Hence, we endeavour to give our students an initiation towards an all round development of their intellectual, physical and aesthetic endowments.

General Information

The school promotes co-education and it admits any child irrespective of caste , creed or social status. To keep up with the rising costs and salary, fees have to be adjusted from time to time. The school session is from June to March. All the students are taught the essentials of religion which are acceptable to people of all faiths and efforts are made continually to develop and draw out values in the life of all the students.

Examinations

Evaluation will be continuous and comprehensive from class 1 to X. The holistic profile of the learner is assessed through evaluation of both Scholastic and Co-scholastic areas. The academic session is divided into two terms.

Students who are absent from examination for any reason will not be re-examined.

If a pupil is not to appear for the whole or a part of an examination for valid reason his / her case will be considered on the strength of the year's record.

In case a student is found using unfair means in examinations, he / she will be awarded zero in that paper and debarred from appearing for the rest of the examinations.

Repetition of the same offence will result in dismissal.

Results of the examinations are final. Parents and guardians are not expected to dictate any terms to the school authorities regarding the child's promotion or detention, which was decided on the basis of the merit of the performance of the child.

No pupil will be promoted before the end of the school year.

Absence and Leave

 $\hfill\square$ The reason for the absence must be explained on the page of the handbook reserved for the purpose, over the parent's signature.

□ No leave of absence is granted for Terminal and Monthly Examinations. Absence from such Test papers and Examinations will be considered a serious breach of school discipline.

 \Box No student will be sent home even if some urgent needs arise, unless a duly authorized person comes to take him / her with a note of authorisation from the parents.

 \Box Student who is absent from class for 15 days or more without intimation, will have their names removed from the roll and they may be re-admitted only after the re-admission procedure.

School Fees

Tuition fees is to be paid in the bank as per the instructions. Those who do not clear all the dues for the year will not be allowed to attend the Annual Examination. Fees once paid is not refundable.

All the dues must be settled in full before the beginning of every examination. If not, the pupils will not be allowed to sit for the examination or issue their Report cards.

NB: If the last date of payment is a holiday, the next school working day will be the last day for the same. Whenever, the fees is paid, please see that it is properly entered in the handbook of the student.
